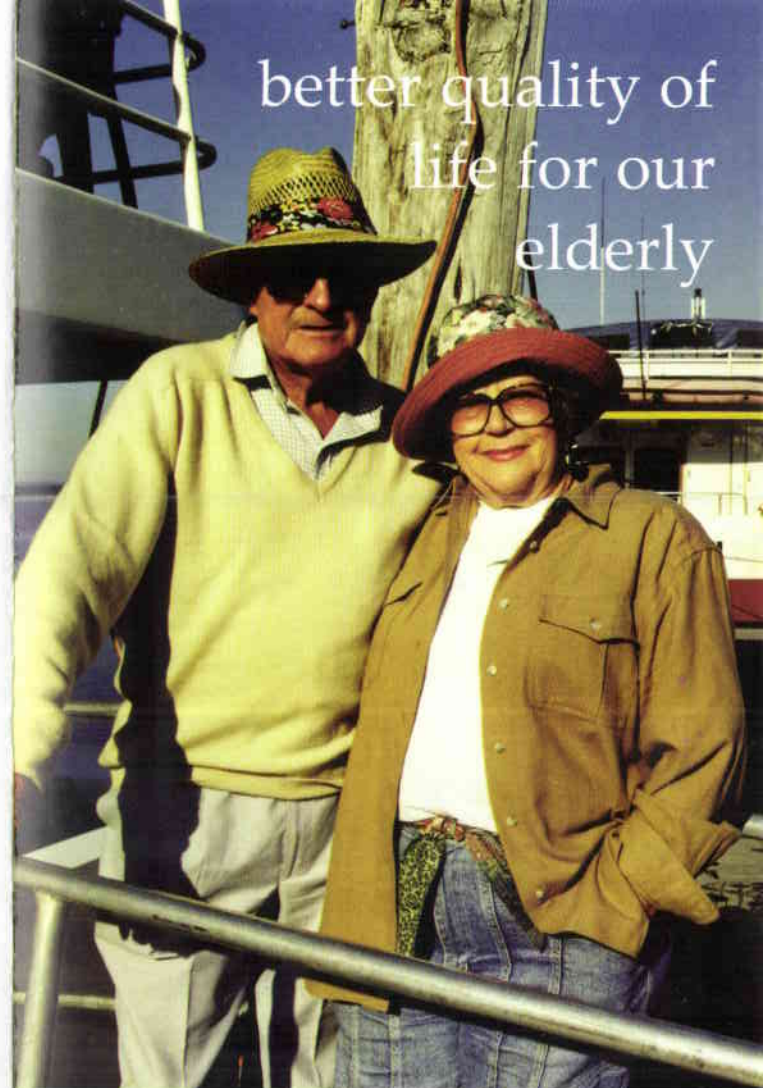

You remain fully clothed and comfortably seated in a special chair... there's no pain, but you can certainly feel it working.

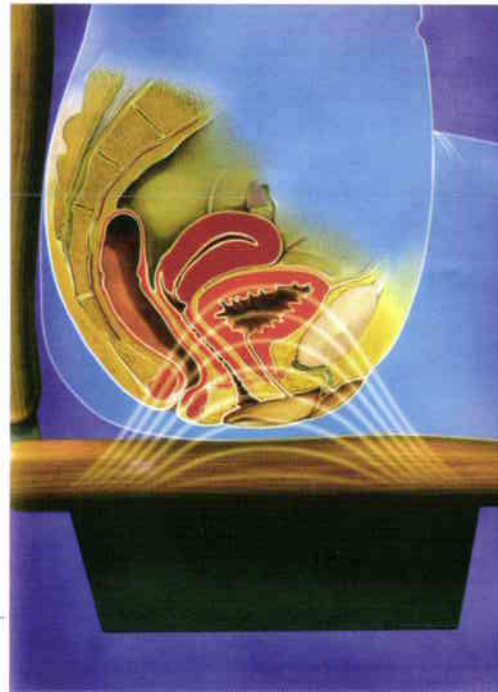
